Thank you for contacting my staff regarding a Joint Terrorism Task Force pamphlet issued by the Phoenix office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.


My staff spoke to Al Shearer who is named on that Joint Terrorism Task Force pamphlet. Al Shearer can be contacted in Phoenix by phone at 602-650-3087. Al Shearer confirmed that such pamphlet was authentic and cited its origins in approximately 1996/97.

After my staff's inquiry, Al Shearer called my staff back to indicate furthermore that JP Weiss who handled this pamphlet can now be contacted in the headquarters of the Federal Bureau of Investigation at 202-324-8286.

I share your concerns about the contents of the pamphlet. It is troubling to see defense of the United States Constitution being cited as an indicator of terrorist threat, amongst other objectionable material.

Let us all do our part to see that such mistakes do not occur again.

The FBI's Joint Terrorism Task Force is attempting to identify criminal activities with domestic terrorists.

In this regard, the purpose of this information sheet is to assist uniformed patrol officers in identifying potential domestic terrorism.

Domestic terrorism is defined as: **Groups or individuals operating entirely inside the US, attempting to influence the US government or population to effect political or social change by engaging in criminal activity.**

In the event questionable activity is encountered, contact the individuals named in this brochure for clarification.



### **Right-Wing Extremists**

- "defenders" of US Constitution against federal government and the UN (Super Patriots)
- Groups of individuals engaged in para-military training



### **Hate Groups**

- Skinheads, Nazis, Neo-Nazis (usually recognized by tattoos)
- Black Separatists
- KKK
- Christian Identity
- White Nationalists





### **Common Law Movement Proponents**

- Fictitious license plates
- No license plates
- Fictitious drivers license
- No drivers license
- Refuse to identify themselves
- Request authority for stop
- Make numerous references to US Constitution
